Background Information

"Litter consists of trash and household toxic substances that are improperly disposed of. Whether the litter is intentional or unintentional, large or small, it can drastically affect the environment for years to come. There is now compelling evidence that cleanup campaigns do make a difference and not just in the short term. Every piece of trash that is taken away to be recycled or deposited in a landfill means there is one less dangerous item for birds, turtles or whales to swallow. Cleanups also restore these creatures' habitats." (UN Environment)
